For prevention, we offer insecticide tablets for impregnating nets, long-lasting insecticide-treated mosquito nets and medicines used for Intermittent Preventive Treatment (IPT).

For detection of Malaria, we offer 3 rapid diagnostic tests: Paracheck[®], Parascreen[®] and ParaMax3[®]. For treatment, IDA offers traditional medication, anti-folate medicines and the especially effective Artemisinin-based Combination Therapies (ACT).
